

**PRIVACY POLICY ON THE PROCESSING OF PERSONAL DATA OF CLIENTS AND SUPPLIERS,  
POTENTIAL SUPPLIERS AND PROSPECTS**

**REG. EU 2016/679**

In relation to the processing of your Personal Data, as hereinafter defined, we inform you that:

**1. Data controller**

The Data Controller is the “Consorzio RFX”, with legal address in Padua (PD – Italy), Corso Stati Uniti n. 4 – 35127, phone number +39 0490829500, email [rpdp@igi.cnr.it](mailto:rpdp@igi.cnr.it) (hereinafter defined “Consorzio” or “Controller”).

**2. Types of Personal Data processed, purpose and legal basis for the processing**

Personal Data refer to any personal data collected and processed by the Controller, including: name, surname, personal information file, role in the company, contact details, email, phone number of the Controller’s clients / suppliers / potential suppliers / prospects and their contact persons, employees and subcontractors. The Personal Data may be collected and processed by the “Consorzio”, for:

- A. Pre-contractual purposes or fulfillment of contractual obligations;
- B. Performance of administrative, accounting, fiscal duties or any other legal obligations related to the contractual relationship.

Therefore, the legal basis for the processing is the fulfillment of contractual obligations in relation to purpose A); performance of legal obligations in relation to purpose B).

**3. Communication of data to third parties – Data recipients**

The “Consorzio” may communicate the Personal Data processed for the above-mentioned purposes to third parties, notably:

- I. Internal company subjects in charge of the processing and internal system administrators in case of intervention on the personal computer;
- II. External subjects including: external consultants and their employees/partners, service companies, banks, insurance companies, control bodies, credit institutions or other institutions.

**4. Transfer of personal data to Third Countries**

Personal Data processed could be transferred from the Controller to Third Countries for the above-mentioned purposes. In this case, the transfer will take place in accordance with relevant legislation about the data transfer pursuant to article 44 and following of GDPR 2016/679.

**5. Methods of processing, storage period and related criteria**

Personal Data will be processed in paper or digital format. Personal Data will be processed by the Controller for the period necessary to achieve the above-mentioned purposes and subsequently for the time needed to comply with relevant law provisions on the storage of contracts and administrative data and for the defense in court proceedings (ten years from the last usage and/or from the actions which interrupt the statute of limitations).

## **6. Provision of data**

The provision of Personal Data is compulsory for the execution of the contractual relationship and for regulatory purposes. Failure to provide the requested Personal Data leads to the impossibility of supplying therein indicated purposes.

## **7. Rights of the data subject, withdrawal of the consent and complaint to the Supervisory Authority**

When the conditions are met, in every moment the data subject has the right to ask for the access, the rectification, the erasure, the limitation of Personal Data, to object to their processing and to exercise the right to data portability.

The data subject has the right in every moment to withdraw the consent eventually given to the processing of Personal Data, without prejudice to the legitimacy of the processing based on the consent given before the withdrawal.

In case of alleged infringement, when the conditions are met, the data subject has the right to lodge a complaint to the Supervisory Authority in the EU member state of habitual residence or in the EU member state of usual working or in the EU member state in which the infringement has eventually taken place.

## **8. Profiling and automated decision-making processes**

The processing is not made through automated decision-making processes (e.g. profiling).

## **9. Contacts and requests**
